





Methodology of EVIL?

What is it trying to say about society?

Creation

The creators, Michelle and Robert King, have said that their creation of "EVIL" came from the want to explore all the different forms of evil present in society.

Faith

Stemed from dinner table conversations about what is the cause of evil. Is it science, genetic, or demonic? The show takes this same perspective on faith and analyzes religion rather than villainizing or endorsing the practice.

Characters

The characters of "EVIL" operate in a gray area. Some are darker shades than others. It is very reflective to reality.

Themes

Evil, Religion, Family, Ethics, Politics, Systems of Government, Mental Health, Science, humorous

Influences

Real-life job, The X-Files, The Omen, The Exorcist, Rosemary's Baby,

Overall

"EVIL" is more about posing questions rather than answering them. There are mysteries that go unsolved. They don't take one side and instead present multiple sides. Not even the demons that exist in the show are necessarily real. They leave it open to interpretation of the viewer.

SIGILS

Phase 1

A repetition of symbols is notoiced among the "monsters of the week" in the show.

Phase 2

The team learns about the Codex when a profit is found filling in missing spots.



Phase 3


The team collects the pieces together to try and understand the meaning. Evil forces are using the sigils and map as influence.







EVIL's Run

- O1 CBS Premiere, 2019
- **02** Renewed, 2020
- O3 Due to pandemic, moved to Paramount Plus, 2021
- 04 Season 2 premiered, 2021

- 05 Season 3 premiered one year later
- 06 Renewed for season 4
- O7 Later announced to be the final season
- O8 Given 4 extra episodes to wrap up series



Cancellation

The creators, cast and crew had plans for more seasons

Reasons for cancellation boil down to money.



Paramount wants to sell and merge.
Therefore they want to "cut off excess fat" to appear more appealing to buyers

Paramount Plus isn't a streaming service with tons of money to throw at the wall hoping something sticks.

The series was at the top of several TV viewership ratings. It received boosts from appearing on Netflix.

Throughout its four seasons, the show received critical acclaim.

The series has a dedicated and loyal fanbase.

Thesis

Streaming algorithms are guided by the greed of large companies, who disregard the importance of compensating creativity, leading to the disintegration of the quality of television and the production formula with many shows on the fringe not getting the attention they deserve as evidenced by "Evil".





Note: There is a balance that needs to be stricken between business and creativity. They cannot exist without one another. However, business is currently bulldozing creativity. If something is not done to control the severity of damage corporations are causing, there may be serious long-lasting damage.

Problem

01

Streaming services are looking to produce "content" for the cheapest and safest possible. Often looking to reboots, revivals and adaptions.

02

The success of a show is determined in the first month of release. Many companies follow an algorithm. There is no time given for an audience to grow over time.

03

Series are producing fewer episodes but taking longer to release seasons. This is due to the streaming services caring less about keeping the audience of the show happy.









"It seemed to connect with people in a really strong way," Robert King said of "Evil" during a recent interview with both showrunners. In this current moment — when the Peak TV bubble has burst, but there's still way too much television — he said, "you're doing things in a void," so when there's tangible proof that a series has had a real impact, "it's kind of magic in a way, when people respond."

Conclusion


TV is at a crossroads. The increased price in streaming services and bundling is in a strange way circling back to cable.


I believe that there needs to be a more sustainable method of production put into place.
